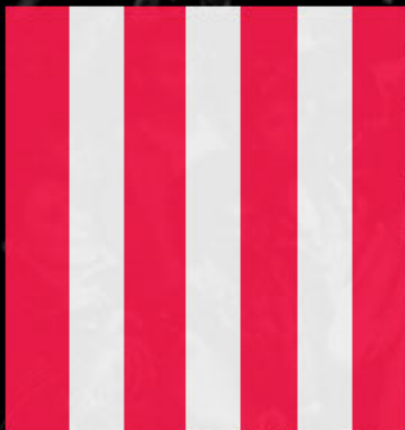

A lot of Dom's music deals with his own personal experiences and stories, so we ask- what's the most profound experience he has emulated through his music and style?

"My music is coded in a way where I say a lot of stuff, but it isn't always as clear. Like nothing ain't everything at the same time, if that makes sense. But, it's hard to say, I just now got comfortable talking about a lot of bad stuff in my music. At first, I wanted to be more like positive. And I am, you know what I'm saying...? But at the same time,, there's a lot of stuff that I did, that I just now got to touch on. Some things that a lot of other rappers may have embraced first, like violence and not always making the best decisions, but I just now started to embrace that because I feel like I didn't want to shed light on that at first. I didn't want to come up on bullshit and negativity."
